Call to order: Paul Bodmer called the meeting to order at 7 P.M.

The following were added to the Agenda:

TYCA adoption discussion
4 C's Task Force
Discussion about a college level individual at NCTE
Hoped everyone would get on E-mail.

Approval of the minutes: Minutes of the November meeting in Pittsburgh were accepted.

Reports:

Treasury: No treasurer at this time. Miles Myers indicated that sectionals do not have treasurers. Discussed how \$2 from each regional member is spent. Paul Bodmer indicated that when he was first in NTCC, NCTE gave a report of the membership money. Miles Myers suggested sending \$2 per member to John Kelley. Nell Ann Pickett mentioned the workshop money from Saturday going to NTCC. Mark Reynolds indicated we have good attendance for the Saturday Workshop. Paul Bodmer felt a treasurer would track the funds for TYCA. Miles Myers indicated he believed the workshop money went to CCCC. Accounting should be in CCCC general revenues according to Miles Myers. Chuck Annal asked why we couldn't set up an account for income for TYCA as new by-laws read? New board would set membership for TYCA.

Discussion occurred re: history of workshops through money granted to the regionals for setting up workshop. Miles Myers stated there is no separate accounting for TYCA. Ben Wiley stressed that CCCC approved Saturday afternoon workshop money in San Diego to go to regionals. Miles Myers feels we need to go back and check that. We expected that workshop money to be the foundation for TYCA. Ben Wiley asked if other groups return the money to NCTE. SLATE does.

Ben Wiley indicated that in recent years, 4 C's has also questioned where the money has gone. Libby Bay asked if the College Section paid money to NCTE? Miles Myers indicated that they did not. Libby Bay then wanted to know why we needed to and Miles Myers said he believed it was because 2 year college organizations cost NCTE money. Some of the regional members are not necessarily members of NCTE so the \$2 is a minimal way to get some membership. Miles Myers indicated he had gone to NTCC to ask if we wanted to be an affiliate and he was turned down. He believes questions still to be answered about membership, TETYC belonging to NCTE, and sections and treasuries.

College Section and regionals have approved the concept of TYCA. The next step is to carry this to NCTE and College Section for specific responses. Mark Reynolds felt perhaps we do not need actual separate funds as long as we have a way to access funds.

Chuck Annal felt we are suspended at this time and Mark Reynolds voiced his concern that we would like to be something different. Ben Wiley indicated we would like to get this organization established so we could find new members for NCTE. Goal is important to find a new way. Miles Myers believes we need to build a membership base through this TYCA organization. Discussion continued.

Miles Myers believes this can work if we dialogue. Libby Bay asked if By-Laws should directly to NCTE Executive Committee for a vote to know where we stand? Should the Board be giving us feedback? Beverly Ann Chin will go over the By-Laws.

TYCA By-Laws: Passed by 5 regionals.

Mark Reynolds: Work has begun. Has an editorial assistant. New cover design for October journal. Journal will be in perfect binding. Some design changes will be made. Have processed 41 entries since January. Another request to Miles Myers for more pages.

NTCC Two-Year English: Essays for a New Century is available through NCTE.

BREAKFAST: Ben Wiley discussed guidelines and donations. Next year the possibility of using 4C's registration was discussed. Motion by Libby Bay to charge \$5 for the breakfast in Washington along with subsidies; Ben Wiley seconded. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

TYCA By-Laws: Approved by Regionals. Elections to wait.

TETYC by TYCA under By-Laws. Miles Myers felt that editor should be selected by NCTE. Discussion followed. Editor of TETYC does not meet with NCTE. Should he/she meet with College English Section? Should TETYC be a publication of the College Section?

NEW BUSINESS:

Task Force for discussion of relationship of 4 C's and NCTE:

1. Continue to place 2 year college as an important regional contact

2. Is there enough two-year representation on the committee? Chuck Annal has been added.

College level hire:

Individual being hired at NCTE to write a job description. Paul Bodmer will talk with the graduate student being asked to do this task.
